
The Vietnam War

French Indochina

- Post WWII- France struggled to keep empire
- Indochina includes Laos,
 Cambodia, and Vietnam
- Vietnamese- 2000 year history of resisting foreign invaders



- 1941- Vietnamese Independence League or Viet Minh established
- Leader- Ho Chi Minh
- waged war against French since the 1930's



The Satellite Theory

- Ho tried unsuccessfully to keep North Vietnam neutral in Cold War
- Can't reconcile with France so he gets recognized by China and Soviet Union
- US supports French
- Dien Bien Phu





US Policy

- Support Ngo Dinh Diem
 - dictatorial
 - disregarded Geneva Agreement
- Kennedy- echoed lke's Domino Theory
 - 16,000 military advisors sent
 - guerrilla war escalates




Gulf Of Tonkin

- USS Maddox- in an "unprovoked " attack
- North Vietnam claims to only have been chasing an attacker from territorial waters (9 mi.)
- Gulf of Tonkin Resolution



US Troops

- Problems
 - Fighting Viet Cong and Viet Minh
 - Guerrilla warfare
 - Jungle
- Support
 - '65 first combat troops sent
 - Great Society (Guns vs Butter)



Communist Plan

- Fight/retreat
- Ho Chi Minh Trail
- tunnels- ability to disappear
- booby traps- use all that you have
- never surrender- outlast the opposition



American plan

- Search and destroy missions
- Bomb more that all bombs dropped in Europe and Asia in WWII



Tet Offensive

- US growing tired of war
- told they were winning (just need 500,000 more troops!)
- Tet showed we weren't in control
- Walter Kronkite
- LBJ approval drops to 36%



Vietnamese

- Southern govts. Never have support of people
- Who were we fighting?
- Did they want us there?
- Did the people in the US want us there?
